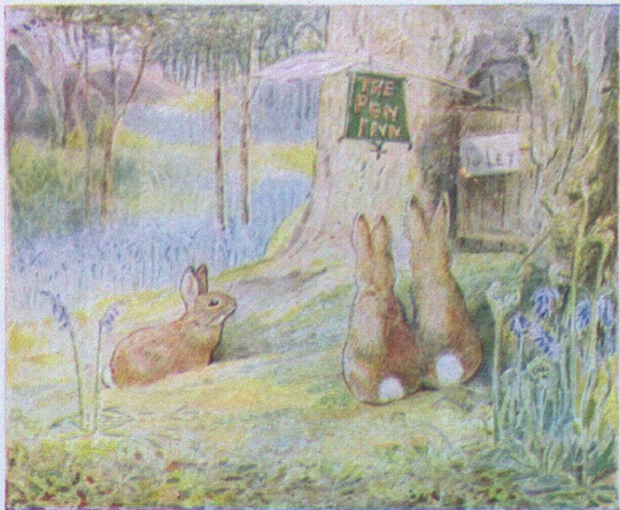




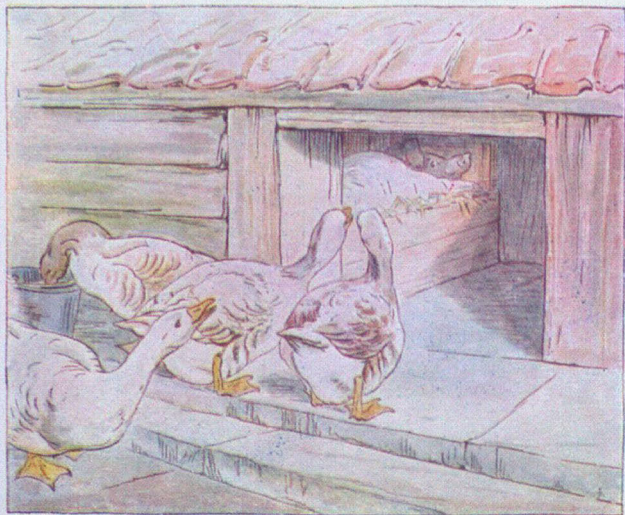
CECILY PARSLEY lived in

AND this pig had none ;

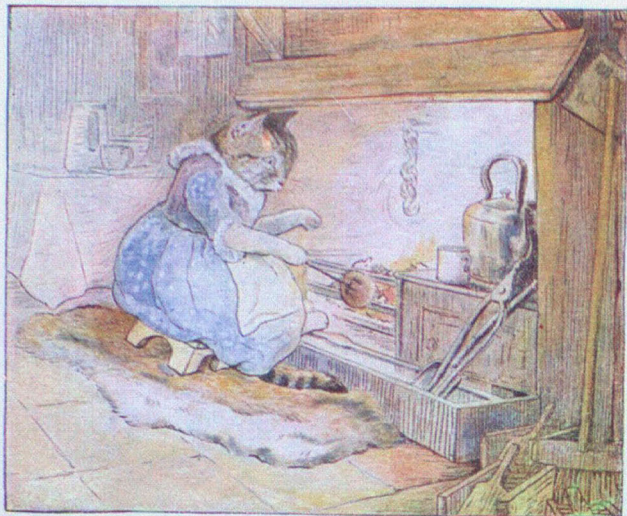




THIS little pig cried

I can't find my way home.







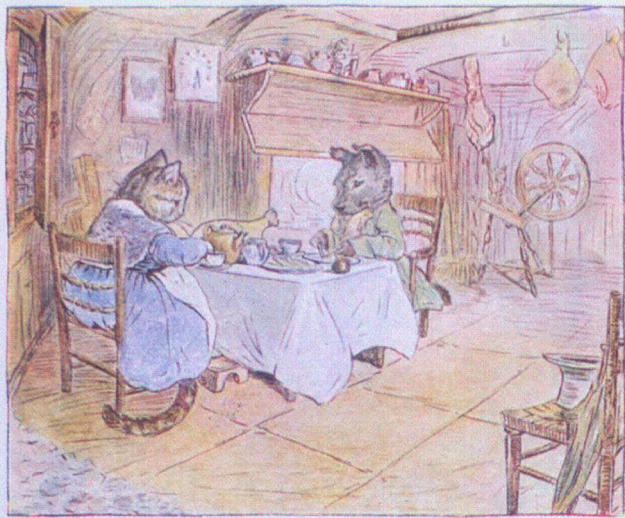
P U S S Y - C A T sits by the

Says "Pussy! are you there?"



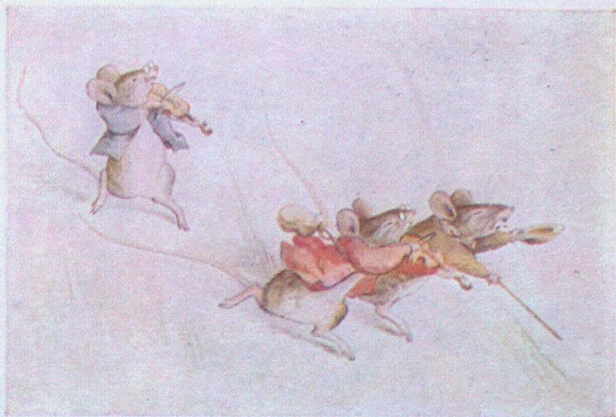

you do ? ”

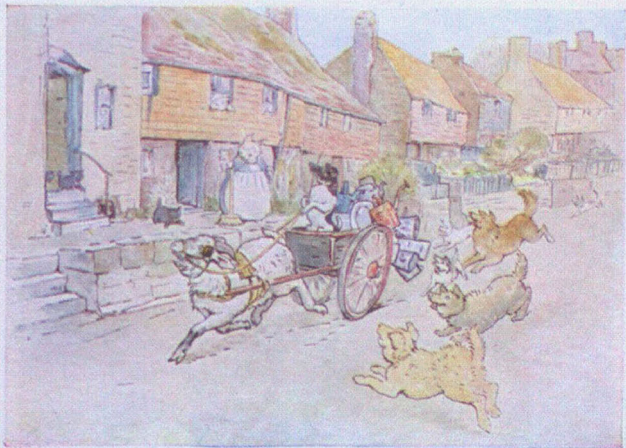
“ I thank you kindly, little dog,

“ I'm little Tom Tinker's dog,

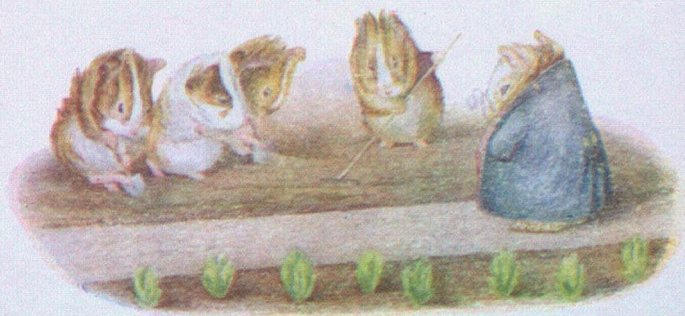
Bow, wow, wow ! ”

sown.





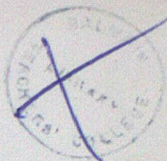
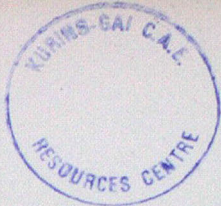

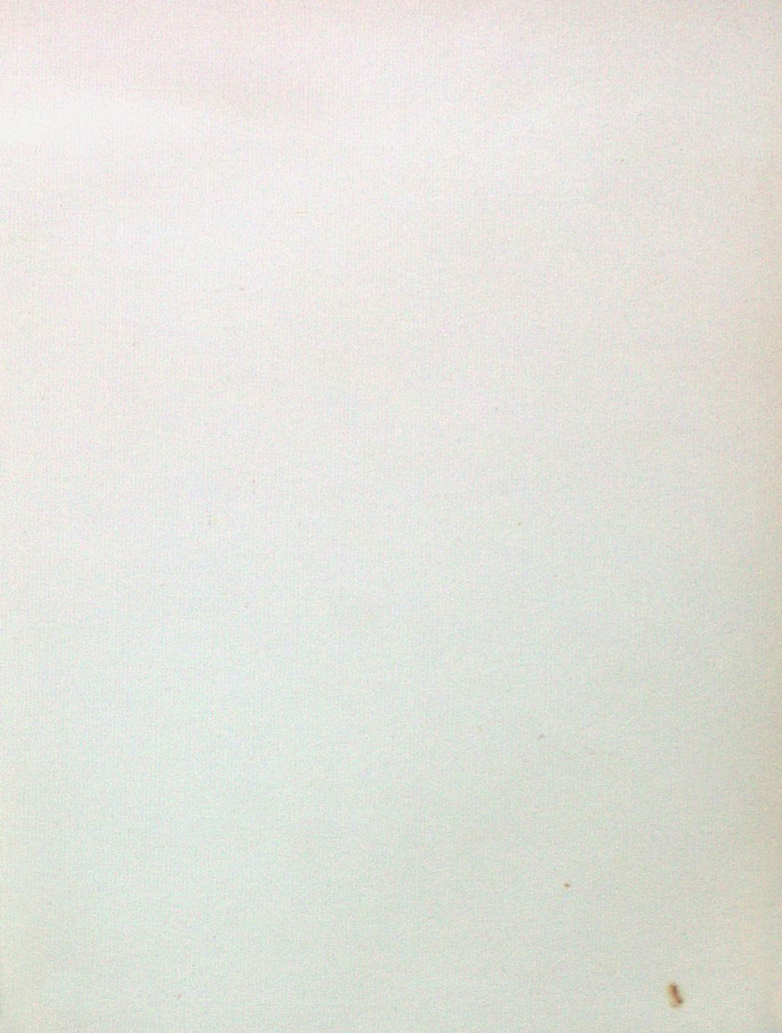
